Department of Classics and Art Studio are sponsoring an art contest for high-school and university students. Vergil Week celebrates the poetry, life, and world of the ancient Roman poet Vergil. The art contest encourages students to create artworks inspired by Vergil's *Aeneid* or Greco-Roman mythology. Artists are especially encouraged to represent characters and scenes from Book Two of Vergil's *Aeneid*. The contest is open to all full-time students at high schools, art schools, and universities.

1. Artists must complete and submit the registration form. Download the registration form at classics.case.edu/vergil-week/.
2. The artist must be able to send by mail or deliver the work to the CWRU campus on or before the deadline of Friday 17 April 2015 at 5 p.m.
3. Artwork will be judged by a panel of CWRU graduate students.
4. The artwork may be in any 2D pictorial or 3D sculptural medium:
Pictorial works must be matted and no larger than 22" x 28"
Sculptural works must be no heavier than 50 lbs.
5. There will be two categories of competition: high school students and university students (undergraduate and graduate). Three prizes can be awarded in each of the two categories:
University/Art School: 1st place, \$125; 2nd place \$75; 3rd place, \$25
High School: 1st place, \$100; 2nd place, \$50; 3rd place, \$25
6. Prizes will be awarded on Monday 20 April 2015 at the CWRU Art Studio.
